PLANTS for COVER

<u>Plant species</u>	<u>Birds that benefit</u>
Abies (fir)	tanagers, grosbeaks and robins
Alnus (alder)	several including blue jay
Andropogon (bluestem)	quail
Crataegus (hawthorn)	cardinals, hummingbirds and other small birds
Ilex (holly)	several
Juniperus (juniper)	Juncos, sparrows, yellow-rumped warblers
Morus (mulberries)	several
Myrica (bayberry)	several
Parthenocissus (woodbine)	smaller birds
Picea (spruce)	Mourning doves
Pinus (pine)	migrating robins and warblers, mourning doves
Quercus (oak)	several
Rhus (sumac)	summering birds
Rubus (blackberries)	towhees, native sparrows, warblers, thrushes and buntings
Tsuga (hemlock)	chickadees, titmice, juncos, cardinals

PLANTS for FOOD

<u>Plant species</u>	<u>Birds that Benefit</u>
Acer (maple)	grosbeaks, bobwhites and cardinals
Alnus (alder)	mourning doves, goldfinches, bobwhites
Amelanchier (serviceberry)	42 species! Including common flicker, red-headed woodpecker, robin, cedar waxwing, gray catbird, bluebird, towhees, chickadees, downy and hairy woodpeckers, wood thrush, brown thrasher, scarlet tanager, red-eyed vireo and house finch
Andropogon (bluestem)	juncos, field sparrows and tree sparrows
Aquilegia (columbine)	hummingbirds
Aster	cardinals, goldfinches, sparrows, titmice, chickadees, nuthatches, towhees and indigo buntings
Betula (birch)	dark-eyed juncos, titmice, black-capped chickdees, cedar waxwings, goldfinches, purple waxwings and warblers
Campis radicans (trumpet vin)	hummingbirds
Celtis (hackberry)	bluebird, cardinals, cedar waxwing, mockingbird, phoebe, bobwhite, pileated woodpecker, red-bellied woodpecker, towhees and titmice
Cornus (dogwood)	downy woodpecker, gray catbird, brown thrasher, robin, wood thrush, bluebirds, cedar waxwing, grosbeaks, bobwhites, mockingbirds and sparrows
Craetageus (hawthorn)	grosbeak, waxwings, blue jays, mockingbirds, common flicker
Empetrum (crowberries)	robins, cedar waxwings, pine grosbeaks and many others
Fragaria (strawberry)	common flicker, wood thrush, cedar waxwings, towhees, robin, gray catbird, brown thrasher, ruffed grouse and quail
Helianthus (sunflower)	mourning doves, red-winged blackbirds, chickadees, house finches, tree sparrows, tufted titmice
Ilex (holly)	49 species including common flicker, mockingbird, gray catbird, brown thrasher, cedar waxwing and robin
Juniperus (juniper)	54 species including cedar waxwing, purple finch, grosbeak, yellow-rumped warbler, robin, mockingbird, wild turkey, jays
Malus (crabapple)	cedar waxwing, robin, mockingbird, purple finch, bobwhite, house finch, red-headed woodpecker, common flicker, evening grosbeak
Monarda (bee balm)	hummingbirds
Morus (mulberry)	59 species including bluebird, cedar waxwing, northern oriole, wood thrush, yellow-warbler, red-eyed vireo, robin, gray

	catbird, titmice and brown thrasher
Myrica (bayberry)	86 species including yellow-rumped warbler, white-eyed vireo, tufted titmouse, common flicker, robins, black-capped chickadee, bluebirds, gray catbird, brown thrasher, northern orioles, tree swallows
Parthenocissus (woodbine)	flickers, red-bellied woodpeckers, tufted titmouse, eastern bluebirds, robins, thrushes, mockingbirds, brown thrashers, black-capped chickadees
Picea (spruce)	chickadees, red-breasted nuthatches, goldfinches and cedar waxwings
Pinus (pine)	chickadees, evening and pine grosbeaks, red and white-breasted nuthatches, brown creepers, brown thrashers, pine warblers
Populus (poplar)	goldfinches, pine and rose-breasted grosbeaks, northern shrikes
Prunus (cherry)	cedar waxwing, house finch, northern oriole, American robin, bluebird, sharp-tailed grouse, gray catbird, song sparrow, common flicker, red-headed woodpecker, cardinal and wood thrush
Quercus (oak)	chickadees, titmice, cardinals, flickers, ruffed grouse, blue jays, meadowlarks, mourning doves, wood ducks, mallards, bobwhites, downy, red-headed and hairy woodpeckers
Rhus (sumac)	98 species including common flicker, red-headed and downy woodpeckers, chickadees, robins, bluebirds, scalet tanager, bobwhite, wild turkey, phoebe, hermit thrush, gray catbirds, brown towhee
Rosa (rose)	cedar waxwing, cardinals, wood thrush, robin, bluebird, mockingbird, grosbeak, bobwhite, goldfinch and chickadee
Rubus (blackberry)	149 species including tufted titmice, red-headed woodpecker, robin, wood thrush, bluebird, cedar waxwing, northern oriole, cardinals, flicker and song sparrows
Rudbekia (coneflower)	house and purple finches, chickadees, cardinals and sparrows
Sambucus (elderberry)	120 species including robins, bluebirds, grosbeaks, flickers, bluejays, brown thrashers, catbirds, waxwings, doves, nuthatches and finches
Sorbus (mountain ash)	(winter food) grouse, cedar waxwings, bluebirds, gray catbirds, orioles, red-headed woodpeckers, brown thrashers and robins
Vaccinium (blueberry)	eastern bluebirds, black-capped chickadees, robins, orioles, tufted titmice, flickers, towhees, and kingbirds

PLANTS for NESTING

Plant species

Birds that benefit

Abies (fir)	Tanagers, grosbeaks, robins and jays
Celtis (hackberry)	indigo buntings, verdins, hummingbirds, white-winged doves, common flicker
Cornus (dogwood)	Bell's vireos and summer tanagers
Crataegus (hawthorn)	hummingbirds, cardinals, buntings, verdins and woodthrushes
Ilex (holly)	towhees, thrashers and mockingbirds
Juniperus (juniper)	chipping sparros, robins, song sparros, mocking birds and others
Picea (spruce)	white-croned sparrows and warblers
Pinus (pines)	robins, finches, mourning doves, magnolia warblers, white-crowned sparrows
Quercus (oak)	blue-gray gnat-cathers, orchard orioles, summer tanagers, woodpeckers, blue jays
Rosa (roses)	indigo buntings, cardinals, yellow warblers, towhees and sparrows
Rubus (black/raspberries)	indigo buntings, cardinals, yellow warblers, towhees and sparrows
Sambucus (elderberry)	warblers, grosbeaks, goldfinches
Tsuga (hemlock)	warblers, robins, juncos, veerys, goldfinches, blue jays and others
